Junior Middle School (Grades 7 and 8)

- Students with at least primary 6 are eligible to apply to Junior Middle School (JMS)
- Offers special custodianship services to young students

High School (Grades 9-12)

- Students with at least Form 2/ Sec. 1/ Junior Middle 2 are eligible to apply
- Graduates are awarded the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)

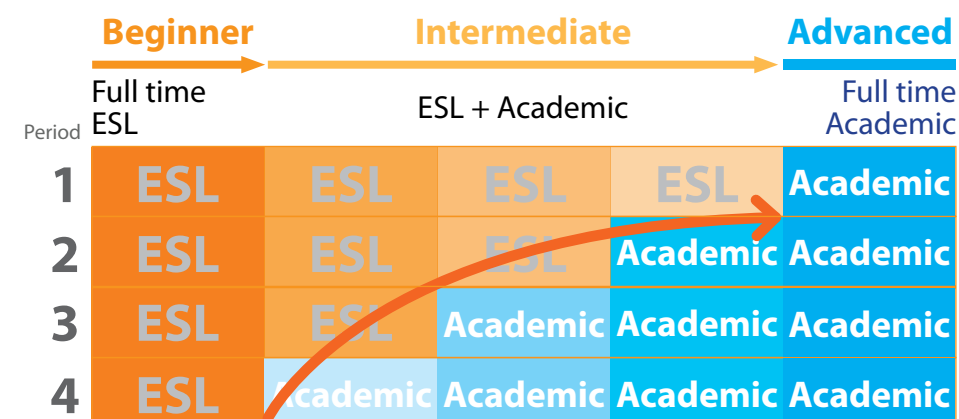

Test Results from Students

- Original iBT/IELTS test results must be provided at the time of registration.
- Only official results are accepted. Projected results are not recognized.
- Students who wrote the test more than 4 months ago may request to write the SLEP test upon arrival at CIC (before registration) in order to update their English proficiency and placement.

Placement Policy

- The equivalency table is based on the best practices in North America as well as research done by both the ESL and Academic English departments at CIC.
- Students arriving at CIC with an IELTS / iBT English Proficiency score will be exempted from writing the placement test.
- Placement is also determined by the original transcripts provided at the time of registration.
- All new arrivals to Columbia International college will be placed in an English/ESL course according to the English Placement Policy.

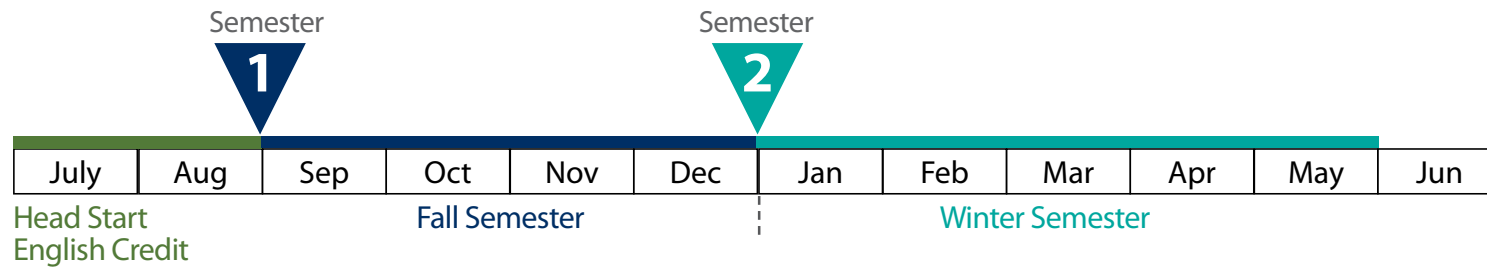
