REFUND POLICY FOR TUITION FEE

- i) A full tuition fee refund, less the administration and application fee (CAD\$800), will be granted if the Study Permit has been rejected by Citizenship and Immigration Canada.
- ii) To obtain a refund, the student must provide:
 - 1. The original Letter of Rejection from Citizenship and Immigration Canada
 - 2. The original Official Letter of Acceptance (if received)
 - 3. The original receipt of tuition payment
- iii) There will be no refund of the tuition fee in the following circumstances:
- if the student chooses to withdraw for reasons other than the Study Permit has been denied by Citizenship and Immigration Canada
- if the student is found in violation of school regulations or discipline policy and asked to withdraw from the school by the principal
- if false medical information was given and conditions were not disclosed
